REFERENCE: Clarification of permitted Junior Category Tyres

Dear Drivers,

In response to queries regarding tyres in the Junior Category, the following clarification is given:

'Road legal' refers to the condition of the tyres, thus meaning that when on track, the tyres must meet normal MOT standards - this includes thread depth and condition.
