



The 2016 AUTOSPORT INTERNATIONAL BTRDA Clubman's Rally Cross Championship - Final instructions.

The British Automobile Racing Club (BARC) will promote a National B permit Rallycross
At Pembrey Circuit, Carmarthenshire, SA16 0HZ on Saturday 16TH & 17TH April 2016.

The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions and / or Official Programme issue by the organising club for the event.

MSA Steward: - T.B.A

Classes as per Championship Regulations.

Sign – on will take place in Race Administration from 7.15 a.m. on both Days. Any competitor not signed on by 8.30am will be deemed as a non starter.

Scrutineering will take place in the scrutineering bay from 7.15 am on both Days.

Engine / Noise Pollution: - Engines must not be run at any time before 8.45am or after 6.00pm on any day

Fuel: - There is no fuel available at the Circuit.

Refuelling:- There is a mandatory refuelling area in the pit lane.

Paddock Return:- Is via the Parc Ferme area adjacent to the Paddock Crossing.

Driver's Briefing: - Will take place outside the Scrutineering Bay at 8.40am

Camping & Entry to the Venue: - Competitor's can enter the Venue from 6.00pm on Friday the 15th April 2016. The Venue will be open 24/7 for Competitor Access BUT will be required to show your Competitor Passes for entry! NO TICKETS NO ENTRY!

No Dogs are allowed on site.

Entry on to Circuit: - All competitors must proceed to the new pit lane area and assemble on the dummy grid when called if after 3 calls for missing drivers from heats or finals that race will proceed.

Exiting the Circuit :- When you have taken the chequered flag for the end of your heat or final cars will return into the paddock as directed by the circuit marshals' Fire Points are situated thought the paddock.

Video Equipment :- Its permissible for competitors to use vehicle mounted video recording equipment for personal use, but they must any such equipment securely mounted, and in place, prior to vehicle scrutineering taking place. The presentation of awards will take place at The Circuit Podium after the Finals on Sunday.
